## CONFERENCE LOCATION

Fès or Fez (فاس in Arabic) is one of the largest cities of Morocco. Fes is one of the four so-called "imperial cities" (the others are Marrakech, Meknes and Rabat). The medina (old city), is an example of an oriental city and it is classified as a World Heritage Site. The special blue of its ceramics is one of the characteristic symbols of Fès. It has the largest town in the world, a single hydraulic clock in front of the BU'INANIYA madrasa and the oldest university in the World " Al Karaouine University ". Due to its past international influence, Fès is one of the capital cities of the Arabic-Muslim civilisation as Damas, Bagdad, Cordoue, and Grenade...

According to a legend, the name of the city would come from the discovery of a pick (Arabic: فأس [fa's], pick) on the first foundation site.

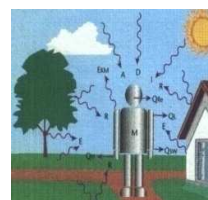
